## **SWS Minority Undergraduate Travel/Mentoring Awards for the SWS Annual Meeting in Washington, DC**

The Society of Wetland Scientists (SWS) announces the availability of minority undergraduate student awards for travel to attend the annual SWS meeting – May 26-30, 2008 in Washington, DC. SWS is committed to increasing membership diversity and is offering full travel awards for support of undergraduate students from underrepresented groups. These awards are supported by the National Science Foundation, the Washington meeting organizers, SWS Chapters (Mid-Atlantic, Pacific Northwest, South Atlantic, Western), and Huffman & Carpenter, Inc.

Please note the following eligibility restrictions:

Undergraduate student participants must be citizens or permanent residents of the United States or its possessions. An undergraduate student is a student who is enrolled in a degree program (part-time or full-time) leading to a baccalaureate or associates degree. Students who are transferring from one institution to another and are enrolled at neither institution during the intervening summer may participate. Spring graduates are eligible; graduates from the fall previous to the meeting date are not.

For the purposes of these awards, underrepresented groups are defined as: Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics and Latinos, Native Americans and Alaskans, Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders, and persons with disabilities.

Please type all requested information in the spaces provided. If any additional space is necessary, please use an additional sheet. Electronic submission of applications via email is preferred. Academic transcripts may be submitted as a PDF file. The application deadline is November 30, 2008.
