SWS Diversity Program Undergraduate Mentoring Awards for the SWS Annual Meeting in Salt Lake City, Utah

The Society of Wetland Scientists (SWS) announces the availability of undergraduate student awards for travel to attend the annual SWS meeting – June 27 – July 2, 2010 in Salt Lake City, Utah and participate in the SWS Mentoring Program. SWS is committed to increasing membership diversity and is offering full travel awards to undergraduate students from underrepresented groups. These awards are supported by the National Science Foundation and several SWS Chapters (Mid-Atlantic, South Atlantic, South Central, North Central, Western, and Pacific Northwest).

Please note the following eligibility restrictions:

Participants must be citizens or permanent residents of the United States or its possessions and be undergraduate students enrolled in a degree program (part-time or full-time) leading to a baccalaureate or associates degree. Students who are transferring from one institution to another and are enrolled at neither institution during the intervening summer may participate. Spring 2010 graduates are eligible; Fall 2009 graduates are not.

For the purposes of these awards, applicants must belong to one of the following underrepresented groups: Blacks and African Americans, Hispanics and Latinos, Native Americans and Alaskans, Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders, and persons with disabilities.

Please type all requested information in the spaces provided. If any additional space is necessary, please use an additional sheet. Electronic submission of applications via email is preferred. Academic transcripts may be submitted as a PDF file. The application deadline is January 30, 2010.
